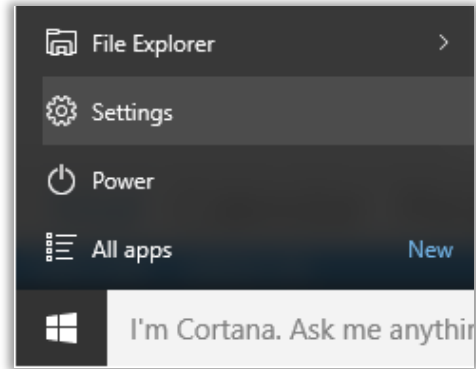


VPN for Windows 10

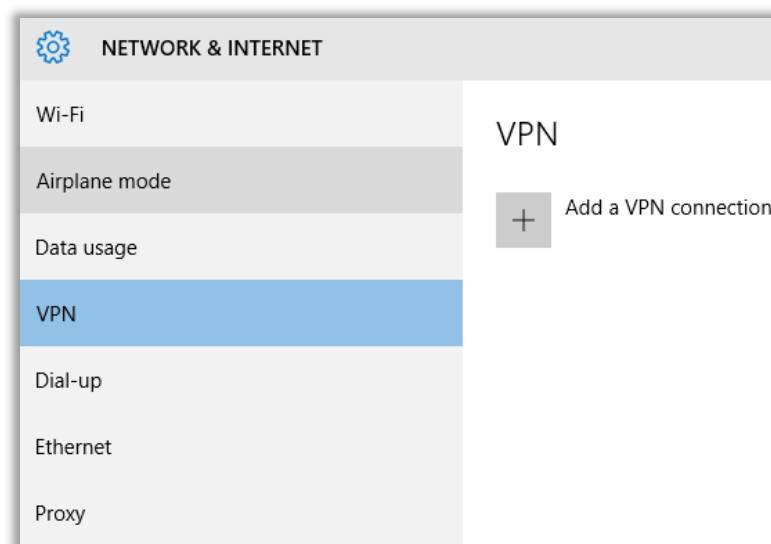
1. Click the **Windows** icon.
2. Select **Settings**.



3. Click **Network and Internet**.



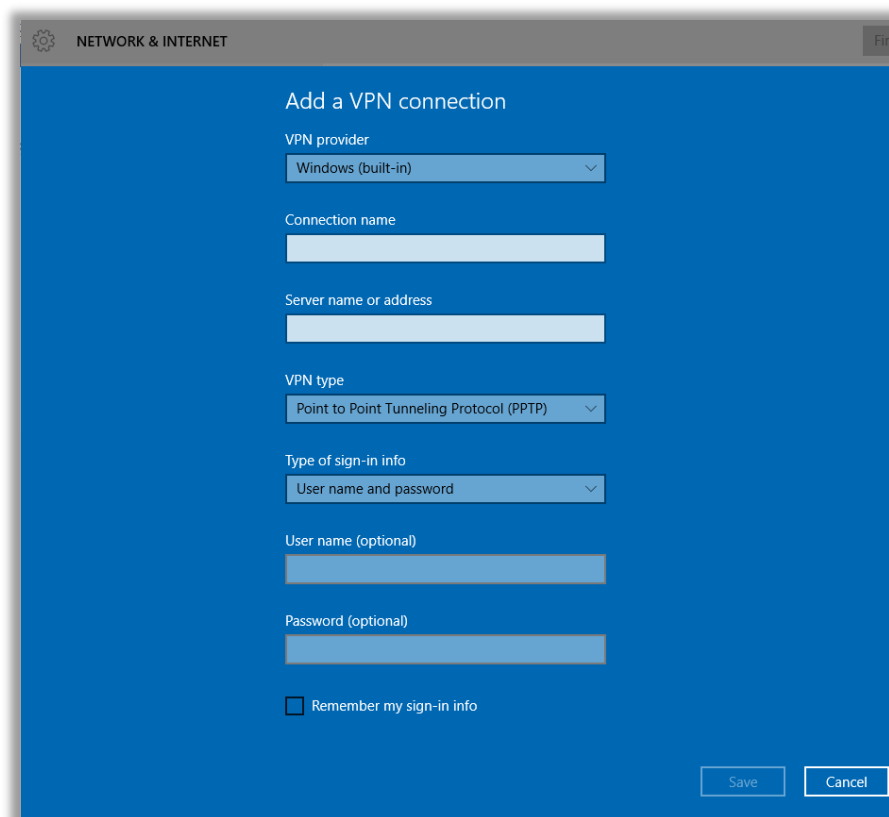
4. Click **VPN**.
5. Click **Add a VPN Connection**.



6. Enter the following:

- **VPN Provider:** Windows (built in)
- **Connection name:** UHVPN
- **Server name or address:** 129.7.254.232 or 129.7.254.233
- **VPN type:** Point to Point Tunneling Protocol (PPTP)
- **Type of sign-in info:** User name and password
- **User name (optional):** CougarNet User ID
- **Password (optional):** CougarNet password

7. Click **Save**.
